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Pamela's Easiest Baby Booties

The easiest baby bootie pattern ever!



MATERIALS

Baby sport yarn or yarn of your choosing

Crochet hook: F

Stitches: Ch, Sc, Dc, Hdc, Sl st, Popcorn, Picot

Finished size: Newborn

Embellishments shown are optional

Baby yarn and hook determines finished size of booties.

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Yarn: Baby Sport Yarn

12 yds approx. for each shoe
10 yds approx. for each cuff
2 yds approx. for each ribbon
4 yds approx. for each pompom

All stitches are worked in both loops unless otherwise noted.

HOOK F

SHOE (see Fig. 1)

Ch 27

ROW 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook and each ch back to starting ch. Total 26 sc

ROW 2-4: Ch 2, turn. Hdc in turning ch and each sc across. Total 26 hdc

ROW 5: Ch 2 (counts as 1st dc) turn. Skip first hdc, dc in each hdc across. Tie off, do not turn, keeping the front side facing you. Total 26 dc

CUFF (see Fig. 2)

ROW 6: Skip first 5 dc, loop up yarn in 6th dc, ch 3 (counts as first dc), dc in next 14 dc. Total 15 dc

ROW 7 (ruffle): * Picot (ch 4, turn, sc in 1st ch made, skip next dc, sc in next, picot made), * repeat across for a total of 7 Picots.

ROW 8: Ch 1 turn. Sc in first sc space, * sc in skipped dc space (see Fig.3 for sc behind picot in skipped dc space), sc in next sc space. * Repeat across to end with sc in last sc space. Total 15 Sc

ROW 9 (ruffle): Ch 1 turn. Sc in first sc, * Popcorn in next sc space (4 sc in next sc, drop loop of 4th, insert hook from back to front (see Fig. 4), to pick up dropped loop, pull tight. Popcorn made), sc in next sc, * repeat across for total of 7 Popcorns.

ROW 10 (ruffle): * Picot (ch 4, turn, sc in 1st ch made, skip next popcorn, sc in next, picot made), * repeat across for a total of 7 Picots. Do not turn, keeping front side facing you.

FINISHING (see Fig.5): Sl st evenly down to row 5 to corner "v" space. Fold piece in half (picot/popcorn inside), pulling pieces together sc across top and front of toe and bottom of sole. Tie off. Weave in all ends. Turn piece right side out, shaping piece, then add embellishments (crochet ribbon, pompoms, satin ribbon).

RIBBON: Leaving a 4" tail, ch 60, tie off, cut leaving a 4" tail. WEAVE crocheted ribbon through a dc row below first picot row, then make and attach the pompoms to the crocheted ribbon.

POMPOM: Wrap yarn around 1 1/4" cardboard or two fingers on the left hand. Wrap until you have enough to cut and fluff (I wound about 40 times around the first and second fingers of my left hand). Cut a 6" piece of yarn, wrap yarn around middle of wrapped yarn, pull tight and tie. Cut each wrapped side of yarn and fluff yarn out to form pompom, you may need to trim as well. DO NOT CUT THE 6" TAIL ends, use them to tie the pompom to the ribbon ends. Trim and cut long ends. *NOTE: Weave ribbon into shoe before adding pompoms.*

TIPS: Alternate colors to coordinate with your baby's outfits. Instead of a crochet ribbon you can also weave in real ribbon.

DEFINITIONS

Chain: Ch
Double Crochet: Dc
Slip Stitch: Sl st
Popcorn: Popcorn

Single Crochet: Sc
Half Double Crochet: Hdc
Picot: Picot



to form Popcorn.


