



Palm Granny Square



It is recommended that you read through all instructions before beginning any project. All work is done in both loops.

** Not responsible for individual changes or substitutions that may alter gauge and finished size including user tension.*

SQUARE INSTRUCTION

To begin ch 5, sl st to beginning ch-1 to form circle.

RND 1 RS: Ch 3 (counts as dc), 11 dc in circle; sl st to beginning ch-3. 12 dc.

RND 2: Ch 2 (counts as sc), sc in same space, 2 sc in each dc around, sl st to beginning ch-2. 24 sc.

RND 3: Ch 3 (counts as dc), dc next 2 sc, *ch 2, FPtr in dc of RND 2, ch 2, dc in fourth sc from last dc made, dc in next 2 sc; repeat from * around, after last FPtr, ch 2, sl st to beginning ch-3.

RND 4: Ch 5 (counts as dc and ch 2), skip next dc, dc in next dc, *ch 2, shell in FPtr, ch 2, dc in next dc, ch 2, skip next dc, dc in next dc; repeat after * around, end with ch 2, sl st to 3rd ch of beginning ch-5.

RND 5: Ch 4, picot in 3rd ch, *(sc, puff, ch 1, sc, picot) in ch-2 space, sc in dc, 2 sc in ch-2 space, sc in tr, picot in next 4 tr, 2 sc in next ch-2 space, sc in dc, picot; repeat from * around, ch 2, sl st to beginning ch-1 of ch-4. Tie off.

MATERIALS

1 oz each Caron Simply Soft, Medium 4, Worsted Weight, colors of choice

Crochet Hook H-8 5.00mm

Stitch markers, Scissors, Tapestry needle, measuring tape

ADDITIONAL PATTERN INFORMATION

Stitches used: ch=chain, sc=single crochet, dc= double-crochet, sl st=slip stitch, tr=treble stitch

Special stitches used:

FPtr=front post treble crochet: Yarn over hook twice, insert hook from front to back to front around stitch indicated, *yarn over and draw up a loop, draw through 2 loops; repeat from * 3 times.

PUFF: [Yarn over, pull up a loop] 4 times in space indicated, yarn over, pull loop through all loops on hook.

SHELL: Make 5 Tr in space indicated.

PICOT: ch 3, sl st to ch-1.

Abbreviations used: RND=round, RS=right side, YO=yarn over

FINISHED SIZE

4 1/2 inches by 4 1/2 inches approximately* depending on yarn and individual work

GAUGE

13 sc by 14 rows equals 4 inches by 4 inches square approximately*

SUBSEQUENT SQUARES JOINING THE JAYGO "Join as you go" METHOD

Step 1: Complete 1st square RND 1 through RND 5.

Step 2: Complete 2nd square RND 1 through RND 4. Begin joining RND 5 at PICOTS as shown in Figure 1 below.


