So, you want to make a blanket are you "designing" or "crocheting a finished pattern"? Size might be a consideration, who are you making it for...a newborn, a tween, an adult, an elderly? See **width** by **length** suggestions below.



### **BABY**

Doll 12"x 12"  
Security 17"x 17"  
Premie 20"x 20"



### **TODDLER TO YOUTH**

Toddler 36"x 48"  
Youth 42"x 54"



### **ADULT**

Lapghan 36"x 48"  
Small throw 48"x 60"  
Medium throw 54"x 66"  
Large throw 60"x 72"



### **QUEEN BED**

Top mattress 60"x 80"  
Drape mattress 90"x 96"



### **CRADLE TO RECEIVING**

Cradle 20"x 32"  
Stroller 30"x 36"  
Receiving 40"x 40"  
Crib 28"x 52"



### **TEEN TO TWEEN**

TV blanket 48"x 60"



### **TWIN**

Top mattress 39"x 75"  
Drape mattress 60"x 90"



### **KING BED**

Top mattress 76"x 80"  
Drape mattress 106"x 96"
